The new work flow for managing credit card statements is an amazing innovation. It'll save hours of time tracking down and reconciling your VISA, MasterCard, and AMEX charges.

The online payment manager is long overdue, I know, but it's worth the wait. It makes keeping track of payments made from your online banking account so simple now. It's easier and faster than writing a check.

C&P X 10.1 streamlined the reimbursement process for employee expense reports. You no longer have to cut a check to an employee before the reimbursement. Just enter that expense report and you're a few clicks away from the A/P invoice that'll automatically pay the employee back on the next

check run. It's foolproof.

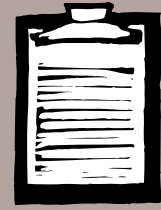
Many users don't realize the Approval Manager will prevent the printing of A/R invoices or paying an A/P invoice until after they have been approved. If you're all about the process, then you'll love it.

## HOW TO UPGRADE TO CLIENTS & PROFITS X 10.2

Installing the Clients & Profits X 10.2 upgrade is easy if you're already using C&P X, less so if you're still using an older version of Clients & Profits:

■ **If you're using C&P X 10.0** The upgrade is available only as a download from [www.cnp-x.com/upgrade](http://www.cnp-x.com/upgrade). The installer copies a new Clients & Profits X application, which needs to replace any previous version. A one-time database registration is needed, as well as activating each workstation (which serializes the application). A quick conversion is required the first time a database is opened.

■ **If you're using C&P Classic/Pro/Job Tracker 5.x** If you are using C&P 5.0.8 (see [www.clientsandprofits.com/whats\\_new](http://www.clientsandprofits.com/whats_new)), the upgrade will convert 5.x databases automatically; if not, follow the instructions in the Installation Guide. An extensive conversion is required the first time a 5.x database is opened, which can take several hours. There are major differences between 5.x and 10.2, so be prepared for a learning curve.

■ **If you're using C&P SQL 1.0** Clients & Profits X 10.2 will convert any SQL Server database, but now requires SQL Server 2005 (Oracle is no longer supported).

■ **If you're using C&P ez/4/PLUS** To upgrade from these 1990s-era versions, call (800) 272-4488. We can convert your database to C&P X 10.2 in less than 48 hours.

■ **If you're using My Clients & Profits!** The new My Clients & Profits! X ([www.cnp-x.com/my](http://www.cnp-x.com/my)) is a free upgrade and packed with new features. Try the free online demo today: [my.clientsandprofits.com](http://my.clientsandprofits.com)

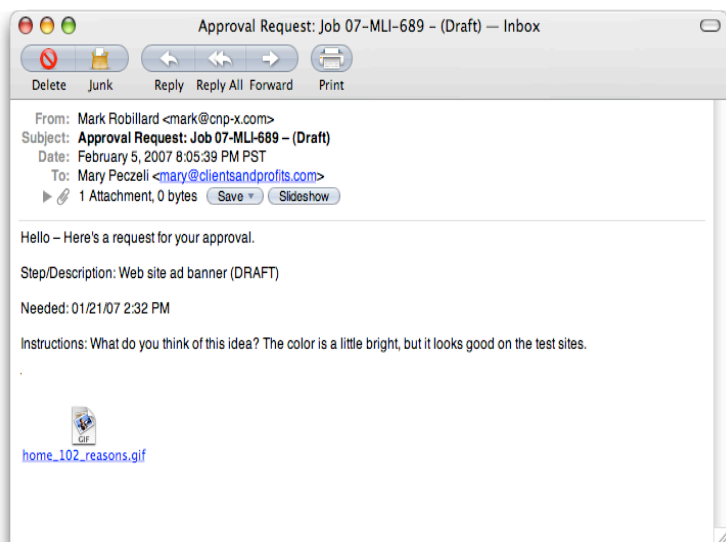

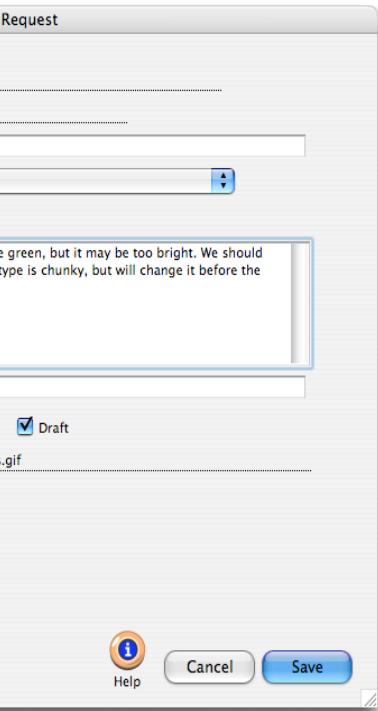

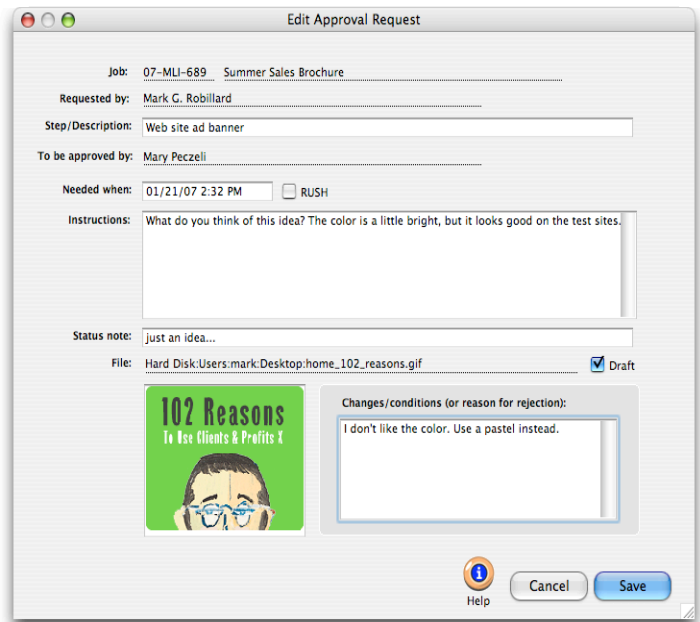

## BEST PRACTICES FOR THESE CHALLENGING TIMES

Even the best of times are a challenge. In good times, it's just keeping up with the work. But in times like these, it's a matter of survival.

**Forget Your Competition** Instead, get your own house in order.

**Pennies Matter, Dollars Matter More** Insist on time cards every day — no excuses, no exceptions. Time is money now more than ever. Remember, a staff member with unbillable time is an expense, not an asset. And don't even consider unbilled time. Count every billable hour and get it billed on time.

**Don't Drop The Ball** Traffic people love their own systems, but enough's enough. Don't let them juggle calendars, spreadsheets, or homemade apps for something as critical as meeting client deadlines. If they're not using C&P X for traffic, they're working twice as hard. And now's not the time to pay for that.

**Prove Your Worth** Use the Client Job Status report to remind your clients how professional, organized, and efficient you are. Always send estimates (and get them signed). Insist on creative briefs (and get them approved). Impress them with automatic client emails that keep them in the loop.

**Act Like a Client** Make sure you're getting the best deal from your vendors. They're hungry too. So use the Vendor RFQs to get three quotes for everything you print. No orders without approval. And pay no invoices

without a purchase order.

**Everyone, Same Page** Make sure everyone has their priorities straight: clients, jobs, deadlines. That's all that matters now.

Always use the auto email alerts for breaking news about job dates, status changes, budget warnings, and approvals.

**Measure Up** Use Snapshot reports to see the big picture. Winners have it all: profitability, productivity, cash flow.

**Bill Early, Bill Often** Get a jump on cash by billing something — anything — when a client approves a job. (Offer a token discount if you have to.) Then bill as the job progresses, even before all the costs come in. You can always send a final billing with lots of detail if the client asks for it.

**Get Paid** Use the Collection Manager EVERY DAY to stay ahead of your unpaid invoices. Let it nag your slow-

paying clients for you.

**Stay Plugged In** C&P X is always on, so rely on it. You have up-to-the-minute stats on your shop at your fingertips. Head bad news off at the pass with change orders, budget alerts, and job status emails.

**Eyes Forward** Bad times don't last. These best practices give better odds that you'll be one of the survivors — and the one rescuing your dead competitors' clients.

**Exclusive Features** Clients & Profits X: Enterprise Edition offers enhanced security and other special features not found in other editions of Clients & Profits X.

With Clients & Profits X: Enterprise Edition, users can upgrade to SQL Server-based performance without losing any of their work — and without learning anything new.

## WORK THE WEB WITH MY CLIENTS & PROFITS! X 10.2

My Clients & Profits! X 10.2 is a brand-new version of the widely-used add-on web server for Clients & Profits X — and a free upgrade, too. There's a lot to like:

**Dramatically faster performance** The new upgrade runs 2-5X faster than My C&P! 5. The server engine has been completely reengineered around Web 2.0 technologies (e.g., slimmer HTML/CSS2 and enhanced Javascript) for improved cross-platform compatibility. And the Mac OS X version uses gzip encoding to greatly reduce network traffic.

**C&P X-like user interface** The My C&P! X web pages were redesigned to look and feel just like the Clients & Profits X desktop application. This means there's virtually no learning curve for web users who know the desktop software.

**Creative dashboard home page** A C&P ASAP-inspired "creative dashboard" home page that displays the user's daily time card, the day's deadlines, their job hot sheet, and the company's in/out board. So they're in the loop even when off-site.

**Online approvals** Use the web to approve A/P invoices, time sheets, and expense reports as well as vendor invoices for payment and client approvals for job content when used with the C&P X approval manager. (See pages 4-5 for an illustrated example of how this works.)

**Online proposals, change orders** Add, edit, approve, print and kill proposals as well as add and edit change orders anywhere you have internet access.

**Pre-billing estimates** Pre-bill job estimates and review unposted client billings from your iPhone (how cool is that?).

**Snapshot reports** Print selected Snapshot production, work in progress, and job reports like the Job Summary.

**Improved compatibility** My Clients & Profits X 10.2 is designed especially for Mac OS X 10.5 (Leopard) and Windows Vista and fully supports MySQL 5, Microsoft SQL Server and the latest versions of Safari, Firefox, and Internet Explorer without plug-ins of any kind.

These performance improvements require no additional server hardware, so My C&P! X 10.2 has the same server requirements as before. While we recommend using a dedicated server for My C&P! X, it doesn't have to be a brand-new server.

Upgrading is easy: it is a simple reinstall. If your users are running Clients & Profits X 10.2, then no data conversion is needed.

### 5 GOOD REASONS TO MOVE TO MYSQL

**#1 Your database is growing** As your database grows, the demands on it increase as more jobs, more tasks, more costs, and more billings are added. Things move slower if the server hardware hasn't been upgraded to handle the volume, especially when a database grows beyond one segment. Because MySQL is a dedicated database server, it is scaled for high volumes of work by dozens of users without straining.

**#2 Your database is slowing down or, even worse, crashing** The built-in Clients & Profits database was designed for simplicity and low maintenance. That's why you don't need an expensive server or an experienced database expert to run it. But the downside is that it's vulnerable to network interruptions and hardware problems. Since MySQL actively manages the database, it is fault tolerant and self-correcting. This means a large database is more reliable.

**#3 You're concerned about reliability** MySQL is an industry-standard open source database, so it is widely used and well documented. There are many tools to monitor the database and optimize its performance that aren't possible with the built-in C&P database.

**#4 Moving to MySQL is not painful** Once your MySQL server is configured, converting your database is easy. C&P X will automatically convert your database into MySQL tables. Then, when each user opens C&P X, they'll connect to MySQL using its IP address and database name—that's all. Everything runs the same as before, except the performance is much faster.

**#5 It's free—and it runs on Mac OS X Server** MySQL is open source, so there are no license fees. And it's available for Mac OS X, so you don't need a Windows box to run it—a big advantage if you have an all-Mac shop.



## UPGRADE FAQs

**Q. Is Clients & Profits X 10.2 really a free upgrade?** Yes! We're so excited about C&P X 10.2's new features that we didn't want cost to keep people from upgrading now. That's why we're offering this upgrade free to support subscribers. This free upgrade is our way of saying thanks for our support subscribers' commitment to Clients & Profits.

**Q. What happens if we don't upgrade this year?** You'll still be able to upgrade, but it will cost extra to wait until 2010 to upgrade.

**Q. We never upgraded to C&P X. Can we still upgrade?** Yes, but not for free. For a limited time we are still offering generous discounts to Clients & Profits 5.x users.

**Q. We let our support subscription lapse. Can we still upgrade?** Yes, but after you renew your annual subscription.

**Q. Is the upgrade process difficult?** No. Here's what to do: (1) download the 10.2 installer from the C&P X web site, (2) trash your C&P X 10.x folder, (3) run the installer and follow the prompts, (4) start C&P X 10.2 then open your current database. The first time you open your database, it will prompt for a one-time conversion. Then repeat steps 2-3 for each workstation. That's it.

**Q. Do we have to upgrade everyone at once?** Yes, everyone must be using the same version of Clients & Profits X.

**Q. What happens to our custom reports or our custom plug-in applications when we upgrade?** Custom reports from C&P X 10.0.x can be converted by opening them in C&P X 10.2. Custom plug-ins aren't compatible and will have to be reprogrammed in Omnis Studio 4.3.

**Q. Is there a data conversion?** Yes, but it is minor and very fast.

**Q. Is there a lot to learn for this upgrade?** No. Everything still works the same way. The new features, such as the online approvals, will take some time to learn if you decide to use them. Most new features have a video tutorial on the C&P web site.

**Q. Will there be any more updates to C&P X 10.0 or 10.1?** No. Those versions have served us well, but have been retired to the Clients & Profits Archives.

**Q. Can we try Clients & Profits X 10.2 before we upgrade?** Of course! You can download the upgrade and try it with your own sample database (don't use your live database, because you can't go back) for 60 days.
